Be Aware

-  Registration does not include camping, those arrangements need to be made outside of registration
-  You are expected to have a full tank of gas
-  Your vehicle must be equipped with a spare tire

-  Inspect your vehicle prior to departure (oil level, tire air pressure, lights etc)
-  Check recovery gear (winch controller, straps, shackles, recovery points)
-  Secure a fire extinguisher and first aid kit in an easily accessible area of the vehicle
- Your vehicle must be in good operating condition (not smoking, no fluid leaks)
-  You must have a GMRS radio
- Remember to always keep the vehicle behind you in sight
-   No alcohol on the trails, bring plenty of other drinks and food
- If you have locking lug nuts, make sure you have the key
-  Tread lightly and always stay on the designated trail
- Stay in your vehicle unless the trail leader has stopped the group
-  Pack out your trash and help maintain the trails by picking up any trash you see
- Trail leader has the right to refuse you or your vehicle if any of the above are not met
- Participants acknowledge they are taking part at their own risk and will not hold organizers or other participants responsible for any accidents or injuries
- No refunds



ATTENTION CAMPERS

- Everyone **MUST** stop at the store to check in upon arrival.
- Car passes are **REQUIRED** for all campers and visitors.
- If not camping and just visiting it's \$5 per car load.
- Truck and Trailer parking is \$10 per trailer for the weekend of camping. \$10 per day if not camping. This is an extra fee on top of your camping fee.
- The campground is not a public place to use our amenities. For paying customers only.
- If **NO** off road event is scheduled, there will be a fee of \$5 per person unless you're camping. This is for staging trucks and general use of the campground.
